Teamwork: Everyone contributes. Environmental delegates will lead the way!

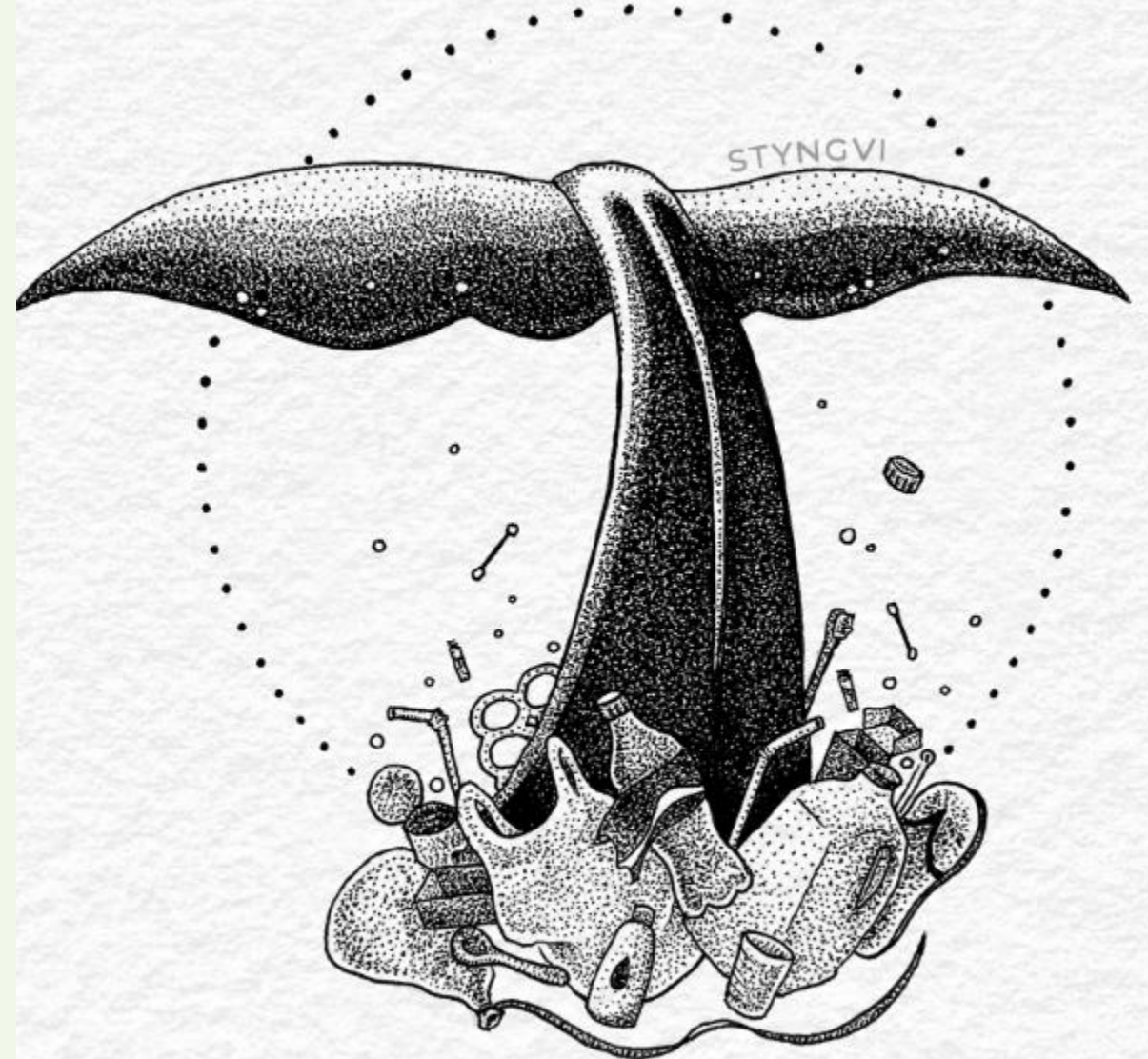
The Plastic Problem
